## MYSTERY

Present day witchcraft is not illegal and the laws have been repealed since the early nineteen-fifties. Unfortunately, the great necessity for secrecy in the past has caused many stories to be invented about it. Because of the mystery and these stories, people come to regard witchcraft as something fearful and evil.

Even in this age of enlightenment, it is equated with such things as sexorgies, voodoo, satanism and black magic, and all the forms of perversion that one could mention, beliefs that are encouraged by the leaders of the various religions.
